



## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

WALAILAK UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

AND

MEIJI PHARMACEUTICAL UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

Walailak University, Thailand, (hereinafter “WU”) and Meiji Pharmaceutical University, Japan, (hereinafter “MPU”) wishing to establish relations between the two institutions, agree to cooperate with each other as follows:

### PART I

#### SCOPE OF COOPERATION

The areas of cooperation shall include, subject to mutual consent, programs and activities offered at either university as felt desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides feel contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two universities.

### PART II

#### GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION

Assistance shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of WU and of MPU through such programs or activities of common interest as:

1. Exchange of faculty members
2. Training and exchange of students
3. Cooperation of research activities
4. Organization of seminars and academic meetings
5. Exchange of academic materials and other scientific information
6. Other activities as mutually agreed

The terms and conditions of such mutual assistance and necessary budget for each program and activity that is implemented under the terms of this agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular programs or activities, and such programs and activities shall be negotiated on an annual basis and as needed basis.

Each party may designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.

### PART III

#### RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

This agreement shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving notice to the other party in writing no later than the end of March in any year. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties.

This agreement may be amended by the exchange of letters between the two institutions. Such amendments, once approved by both institutions, will become part of this Memorandum of Agreement.


